

SBDM Notes: 10/23/2017

Call to order: 3:27 PM, 1st motion, Susy Napier, 2nd motion, Jeff McFarlin

The committee approved the prior minutes and started reviewing the budget for the Elementary District Activity Accounts. Enrollment is up we gained eight students this past week. We have money for professional development for the high school and elementary school. Fifth grade is using a math program called Reflex math that seems to helpful to the students.

The committee has been discussing what they want in the public speaking policy. If anyone would like to speak at a meeting they must first have prior approval. The members will come up with a form that must be filled out with information regarding what they wish to speak about. There must be a time limit, which should be between two and five minutes. The discussion at the meeting should be confidential to the students and staff.

The school will be hiring a preschool aide, so the committee will be interviewing on November 9, 2017. The new hire will begin on November 13th.

The fourth and fifth grade teachers will be starting a new way of rotating students after Thanksgiving. The students will no longer be by grade level, but by ability level. All students will have two math classes, which is our main focus according to KPREP. The students that need the most help in reading and math have very low numbers in their classes, so the teachers can really focus on what the students need. Ms. Sparks is stepping in as a fifth rotation for reading and science.

The members of the committee want all practices that involve the gym to start after 4:00. This allows time for the coaches to arrive and so the students have the supervision that they need. The members want to make this a policy and will be discussing this at the next meeting.

Next meeting will be November 9, 2017 for the hiring of the preschool aide. There will not be a meeting in December. Mrs. Dornon will notify the committee in January for meeting notice.
