

SBDM Notes: 9/25/2017

Call to order: 3:31 PM, 1st motion, Jeff McFarlin, 2nd motion, Whitli Pridemore

The members of the council approved the August minutes. Ms. Sparks explained how she will utilize the ELA PLC group in the Writing policy. The members of the English PLC committee will be taking an active part in assessing the writing portfolios every nine weeks with Ms. Sparks. The teachers, kindergarten through fifth grade, will be sending writing portfolios to Ms. Sparks. They will include a high, middle, and low example to the committee to review. There will be an example of either a narrative, informative, and argumentative piece. There will also be an On-Demand, constructed response, and at least one piece that has gone through the writing process each nine weeks. The writing portfolios must also show that technology has been used in at least one piece. Ms. Sparks will share the data with Mrs. Dornon.

The committee reviewed the budget that Mrs. Burnside sent Mrs. Dornon. Mrs. Dornon explained that the final budget would change because of enrollment and stipends. She also explained that the library budget would change also because of the student enrollment. The library budget is the total number of kids multiplied by 15.

The next item of the agenda is to create a by law addition for public speaking. The members believe that there should have time limits and should be confidential about students and staff. Mrs. Dornon will create a draft and the members can send any ideas they wish to add to the draft.

Positive KPREP test score results are: On-Demand Writing-Novice decreased from 35.7 to 15.9, Proficient increased from 12.5 to 20.5. Language Mechanics-Novice decreased from 26.1 to 23.2, Apprentice decreased from 37 to 32.1, Proficient increased from 21.7 to 32.1. Social Studies- Novice decreased from 21.4 to 15.8, Apprentice decreased from 48.2 to 34.1, Proficient increased from 28.6 to 50. Reading- 3rd grade Distinguished increased from 13.8 to 15.9, 4th grade Novice decreased from 28.3 to 24.2, 5th grade Novice decreased from 25 to 20.8.
