

SBDM Notes: 4/30/2018

Call to order: 3:23 PM, 1<sup>st</sup> motion, Jeff McFarlin, 2<sup>nd</sup> motion, Eugeni Greene

The committee went into closed session at 3:23 to discuss personnel and next years staffing. The committee returned at 3:35.

Natalie Dalton and Angie Reihns, members of the PTO, came to speak to the committee about the fifth grade graduation. The PTO is willing to help with the fifth grade graduation this year and the years to come. "Whatever we do this year we will do the following years." The PTO representatives are wanting to rent the Fairview Baptist Community Center. The fifth grade teachers would need to be present. At first the PTO representatives were asking for \$25, but then heard that may be too much. So they were going to ask for \$10, which would include the following items: tassel, cap, t-shirt, and autograph book.

Mrs. Dornon said, "We are not allowed to ask for money. But if the money went to a company for a t-shirt, then that would be okay. For example, Mrs. Pridmore's FPS team had t-shirts made by Mrs. Snyder. Then Mrs. Snyder provided an itemized receipt."

Natalie said, "If money goes to a company for a shirt that would be okay. The shirts would be \$12.00." Some of the ideas for the fifth grade graduation were feeding the kids pizza, using prom decor for decorations, having the students wear their t-shirts instead of Sunday best, invite parents for awards, order a sheet cake.

Mrs. Dornon suggested cupcakes. Last year the fifth grade teachers used cupcakes and it was much easier. Mrs. Dornon also told the representatives that there would be a cost for transporting the students to the community center. The PTO said they would pay for the transportation. Then Mrs. Dornon said that she would have to check with Terri to see if buses would be available. Mrs. Dornon stated that it can sometimes be difficult to get a bus during this time of year due to field trips. Mrs. Dornon communicated to the PTO representatives that she would let them know by the end of the week if graduation would be taking place at the elementary school or at the Community Center.

The members of Site Base conversed about fifth grade ceremonies. They all agreed that the PTO representatives would make the commencements nice wherever they took

place. So the committee was unanimous in their decision to keep fifth grade graduation at the elementary.

The members of the committee looked over the financing report. There will probably not be anymore textbook money. There is around \$25,000 in the account. The school uses this money when the copier needs fixed, for elevator maintenance, teacher money, and for lawn care.
